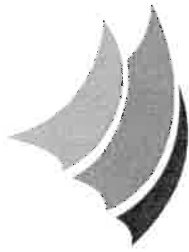

One (1) each NEW MARINE MAMMAL MEDICAL LIFT

The City of Gulfport, the Gulfport Redevelopment Commission and the MS Aquarium are soliciting bids for One (1) each new Marine Mammal Medical Lift in support of the MS Aquarium.

General Specifications:

The lift will be constructed to accommodate a pool size of 15' X 8' with animal safe, non-corrosive materials, such as aluminum or stainless steel. Lift must accommodate a salt-water aquatic environment. These specifications shall be regarded as minimum. "Example of scissor lift provided in Attachment "A".

Bidder MUST answer YES or NO in the appropriate column for each line item and provide specific data as appropriate. Failure to answer correctly, or failure to respond, will deem your bid as non-responsive. All line items with a "NO" response, shall be explained in detail.
