What the job involves:

The mission of the Gulfport Police Department is to protect and serve the citizens of Gulfport.

Working conditions:

This position requires shift work meaning you will be required to work a variety of day, evening , and overnight, (“graveyard”) shifts, including weekends and holidays.

Requirements: 21 years of age, have a High School Diploma or GED, and a valid driver’s license. Reside in one of the following counties: Harrison, Jackson, Hancock, Stone, Pearl River, or George County, Mississippi within six calendar months following employment. Applications must be received by Human Resources by **Thursday, May 30th, 2019 at 4:00 p.m.**
